



Mountains are calling

It's time to rediscover the Transalp; a bike so versatile that it refuses to be categorised, transcending traditional bike classes to become the original all-rounder.

Meet a new generation of mid-size adventure motorcycle featuring impressive on-road touring comfort for two and genuine off-road ability. And with class-leading 67.5 kW power and 75 Nm torque from its 755cc, twin-cylinder engine performance is full-blooded and responsive, around town or out on the open road.

A lightweight chassis delivers easy on-road handling plus off-road control, with the supple reaction of longtravel suspension. Compact dimensions also ensure this is an easy bike to manage at low speeds while it's also comfortable, with fairing and screen built for aerodynamics and wind protection, and riding position tailored for all-day riding.

The XL750 Transalp is also loaded with features that riders appreciate; 4 default riding modes, including Gravel setting and customisation options, the confidence of Honda Selectable Torque Control (HSTC) and full TFT screen with the convenience of Honda Smartphone Voice Control system connectivity.



Power and torque tuned for versatility.

Sure, the headline figures grab attention...

67.5 kW power and 75 Nm torque are strong numbers and driving a lightweight 208 kg kerb weight. But it's the way the all-new, 755cc 8V parallel twin-cylinder engine delivers that you'll really notice. Our patented air vortex intake technology amplifies and smooths low- and mid-range response, while the cylinders use high-specification Ni-SiC plating to reduce friction - and increase power - at high rpm.

This engine is also about feel. A 270° crank delivers delicious, off-beat low- and mid-rpm character and the exhaust note gives a rich pulse off the bottom and through the middle of the rev-range. For control, an assist & slipper clutch eases upshifts and manages the rear wheel under rapid downshifting.

On a dirt track, around town or touring out on the open road, two-up and fully loaded, this engine is tuned versatile performance. You can also choose your XL750 Transalp with 35kW from new - so it's A2 licence compatible. And, once you have your full motorcycle licence, a Honda dealer can re-write the ECU to put full power in your throttle hand. How's that for planning ahead?









If you're spending all day getting somewhere, reduced fatigue matters and the Transalp slips through high-speed airflow efficiently for more relaxed highway cruising. Its adventure styling has purposeful look and feel, with zero excess and is built for tough, long-haul reliability.

We've designed the XL750 Transalp to be the perfect partner for your adventures, wherever they lead.

But it's also designed to be rider friendly and whether dealing with the urban sprawl, covering big highway distance, or navigating endless trails the midesection's slim proportions combine with a sleek fairing that gives wind protection without bulk. And, of course, the beautiful Tricolour paint option pays homage to the original XL600V and marks the return of an icon.

This bike is built to go the distance.

As a true all-rounder the XL750 Transalp can cover the daily commute or long-distance tour, and all points in between. An 850 mm seat height and 208 kg kerb weight makes it an easy bike to manage from walking pace upwards; the handling is light and confidence-inspiring, the riding position is relaxed yet upright, offering great visibility and natural comfort. The seating is also designed for two to enjoy. Compact and highly functional, the fairing and screen feature aerodynamics carefully sculpted to increase stability and reduce wind noise and buffeting at speed.

At just 18.3kg, the steel diamond-style main frame is light and integrates a sturdy rear subframe to support long-range touring loads; a rear carrier is also fitted. A forged aluminium top yoke ensures steering precision, while the aluminium swingarm operates through Pro-Link for supple control.

And it's good to be prepared. From dirt tracks to green lanes, long-stroke Showa[®] suspension absorbs bumps, while the 21 and 18 inch front and rear wheel combination roll smoothly over rough terrain.

Use riding technology that makes a difference.

The XL750 Transalp is ready for anything. Throttle By Wire delivers precise engine management, and four default riding modes - Sport, Standard, Rain and Gravel - make it easy to set for most conditions you'll encounter. They each deftly alter the level of Engine Power and Engine Braking, Honda Selectable Torque Control (HSTC), Wheelie Control and amount of ABS intervention. User mode allows your custom preference of each parameter (including rear ABD switch off for off-road)) and management is via a full-colour 5-inch TFT screen, which is customisable with 4 distinct types of display.

And keep in touch while you ride: the Honda Smartphone Voice Control system, through the Honda RoadSync app, allows you to access your android or iOS device via Bluetooth headset for navigation, calls, messages and music. There's also a USB charging socket under the seat.

All lighting is premium LED, and for an extra level of visibility Emergency Stop Signal (ESS) technology alerts road users behind of sudden braking, by operating - and then switching off - the rear indicators.

It's the XL750 Transalp's powerful, characterful twin-cylinder engine, nimble chassis with long-travel suspension, tough bodywork, sleek aerodynamics plus top-draw specification – and the way they all work together.



1. Authentic adventure touring style

Rugged and efficient, the design of the fairing and screen deliver efficient high-speed performance without bulk; a slim mid-section aids control and ground reach.

2. All-round comfort

With kerb weight of 208 kg, 850 mm seat and upright riding position the XL750 Transalp is comfortable, easy to ride and a complete all-rounder – around town or on the open road.

3. High performance versatility

755cc, short stroke 8V parallel twin-cylinder engine produces 67.5 kW power and 75 Nm torque, with air vortex and downdraft intake technology plus Ni-SiC cylinder plating.

4. Engaging feel and sound

A 270° crank delivers appealing low-rpm character. And the exhaust note delivers a rich pulse off the bottom and through the middle, rising to a soulful howl at high rpm.

5. Assist & slipper clutch control

For a light lever load, help with upshifts and smooth control of rear wheel 'hop' under hard braking and rapid downshifting.

6. Riding modes plus full custom option

Throttle By Wire (TBW) precision equals 4 default riding modes: Sport, Standard, Rain and Gravel, as well as the option to customise all the parameters.

7. Electronic control

Honda Selectable Torque Control (HSTC) operates through 5 levels of intervention to manage rear wheel traction, with differing levels of Wheelie Control to limit front wheel lift.

8. 5-inch Full Colour TFT Display

Customisable and equipped with Honda Smartphone Voice Control system so you can access your device via Bluetooth headset for navigation, calls, messages and music.

9. Long travel confidence

Showa® 43mm SFF-CA USD forks deliver 200mm travel; the remote reservoir Showa® shock operates through Pro-Link with 190mm travel. Both are preload adjustable.

10. A2 licence option

You can choose your XL750 Transalp in 35kW, A2 licence compatible form from new and a Honda dealer can convert to full power via an ECU rewrite once you're fully licensed.



Because, after all, it's our dreams that move us.








