



A reflection of you.

Back in 1962 our very first street scrambler, the CL72, made its debut.

Now it is time for a new breed to roll out, for the streets of today. The new CL500 drips with raw style and detail that only comes with long history. It also packs a strong, A2-compliant twin-cylinder engine into a sturdy, compact chassis and begs to be ridden, customised and enjoyed.

The riding position is naturally upright for excellent control, while the compliant suspension and 19 and 17-inch front and rear wheels soak up rough ground. Producing a healthy 43.4 Nm torque the engine has been tuned for crisp response and smart acceleration. It also features an assist/slipper clutch to make gear changing up and down the six-speed gearbox smooth and easy.

Authentic details are everywhere, like the upswept twinexit exhaust muffler, high handlebars, rounded fuel tank and black rubber fork gaiters. Premium LED lighting is a contemporary touch. And there's so much you can do – with a vast range of Honda Genuine Accessories – to make the CL500 just the way you want it to look, feel and ride.



Look the part.

Retro modern looks packing raw, simple honesty.

Our CL500 style starts with the 12L fuel tank; smooth, rounded and perfectly formed, with authentic rubber knee pads for comfort. And everything that can be – engine, frame and suspension – is blacked out for sleek, minimalist looks. Rubber gaiters protect fork legs, just like back in the day.

High, wide handlebars give excellent control and, in true CL tradition, mirror the evocative upswept exhaust muffler, with its distinctive drilled stainless heat shield and twin-pipe exit that sits just right.

For easy control and turning in an urban area, the riding position is upright, with arms and knees placed in a comfortable, natural posture. It also gives you great all-round visibility. There's also plenty of room on the flat seat to move back and forward, allowing for a more aggressive attitude. And to keep things simple, a neat, 100mm ring houses the negative LCD display. Information on show is just what you need and includes gear position indicator, fuel consumption and individual left/right indicator arrows.







Instant, vintage off-road credibility bolts on with the headlight visor, knuckle guards and side number boards. There's also a high front mudguard to complete the look.



Stand out individuality.

We have built the CL500. It's up to you to make it yours.

Which starts with colour; choose between vibrant Candy Orange or Blue Metallic, ultra-modern Mat Gunpowder Black or rugged, earth-toned Mat Green. Then add what you need for how you ride or look you want - the rear subframe mounts all sorts of Honda Genuine accessories including large soft rear bags.

The classic round headlight features four bright LED bulbs for a distinct light signature. But full LED lighting is also energy efficient, runs cooler and the bulbs last longer. Most importantly, visibility to other road users is much improved.



Ready to ride.

This is a bike built to handle whatever you've got.

From dirt roads, cobbled city streets or weekends away. Seat height is 790mm and the mid-section slim, great for easy ground reach and low-speed manoeuvrability. There's plenty of leg room (a taller seat is available as an optional accessory), while the pillion seat mounts low for easy access.

41mm telescopic front forks feature 150mm travel for supple control, and the Showa® rear shocks are spring preload adjustable. There's the surefooted stability - from walking speed upwards - of a 19-inch front and 17-inch rear wheel and deep-groove tyres, while the 310mm floating front disc and two-piston caliper ensure progressive stopping power, with ABS optimised for dirt tracks as well as road.

Built-in Emergency Stop Signal (ESS) technology alerts those behind of sudden, hard braking by operating - and then cancelling - the rear indicators as hazard lights.









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Either way, you will love this engine and, with 34 kW peak power, the CL500 is ready for an A2 licence holder. Parallel twin-cylinder, DOHC 8V and spinning a 180° crank, it's so easy to use at low speed, with smooth throttle response, easy-going power delivery and soulful sound.

And, thanks to intake, exhaust and gearing, there's strong torque all the way through the rev-range - with peak of 43.4 Nm @ 6,000rpm - which equals acceleration, when needed, that even the most experienced will enjoy.

The engine's assist & slipper clutch is designed to help you ride; it assists with a light lever load and makes for smoother, easier gear changes up and down. And you don't have to juggle engine rpm or worry about the rear wheel locking up on multiple down changes - the slipper function takes care of that.

Inspiration from the past makes the CL500 the perfect scrambler concept for today.

Not many manufacturers can draw on a history like Honda's – which gives the CL500 a perfect mix of authenticity, cutting-edge modernity and sheer engineering quality.



1. Retro modern scrambler style

Inspired by the original 1962 CL72 the CL500 mixes old school style and new school modernity, just right for today. Blacked out running gear and engine enhance the look.

2. Authentic details

Smoothly rounded, the fuel tank wears comfortable rubber pads. Signature high, wide handlebars match the high-level exhaust muffler, with drilled stainless heat shield.

3. Cool paint options

What's your flavour? Choose between vibrant Candy Orange or Blue Metallic, ultra-modern Mat Gunpowder Black or rugged, earth-toned Mat Green.

4. Huge custom potential

You can easily mount large and small Genuine Honda soft rear bags while instant, vintage off-road credibility bolts on with headlight visor, knuckle guards and side number boards

5. Easy handling

A 19-inch front wheel, longer travel suspension and deep-grooved tyres ensure confidence from walking speed. ABS performance is optimised for braking for road and dirt tracks.

6. Natural riding position

Seat height is 790mm and the mid-section slim, great for easy ground reach and low-speed manoeuvrability. The pillion seat too, is low and flat for straightforward access.

7. A2 Licence compatible

35kW peak power means CL500 is ready for an A2 licence holder. The engine's delivery and character are also well-mannered and easy-going, especially low down in the rev-range.

8. Enjoyable twin-cylinder performance

DOHC 8V and spinning a 180° crank there's strong torque all the way through the rev-range \neg - with peak of 43.4Nm @ 6,000rpm – which equals hugely enjoyable acceleration.

9. Assist/slipper clutch control

For a light lever load, help with upshifts and smooth control of rear wheel 'hop' under hard braking and rapid downshifting.

10. LED Lighting

The classic round headlight features four bright LED bulbs for a distinct light signature. And, most importantly, visibility to other road users is excellent.

11. Minimal LCD Display

A neat, 100mm ring houses the negative LCD display. Information includes gear position indicator, fuel consumption and individual left/right indicator arrows.
